PRAYER

Little Black Books

Suggestion for Prayer

Use or purchase a bible or borrow a book of Lenten prayers and meditations to use during Lent. Meditate on the call of each week's Gospel. For readings, go to www.dailygospel.org.

Attend daily Mass as often as possible.

Participate in Lenten Programs

Walk the Stations of the Cross in the Chapel or the Memorial Garden.

Commit to 20 minutes of prayer each day.

PERSONAL PENANCE

- Fasting: As Catholics (ages 18-59), we are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is appropriate throughout Lent.
- Abstinence: As a sign of penance, we (ages 14 and older) abstain from all meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.
- Almsgiving: Operation Rice Bowl – Program begins the weekend of February 3rd and ends Holy Thursday.
Prepare Sandwiches for the homeless after the 10:30 AM (1st & 4th Sundays) and 12:30pm Masses (2nd & 3rd Sundays).
Bring toiletries and/or food donations to Sunday Mass each week
Donate to the Francis fund “Yellow Envelope” for those in need.
Volunteer for bread packaging and distribution after daily Mass

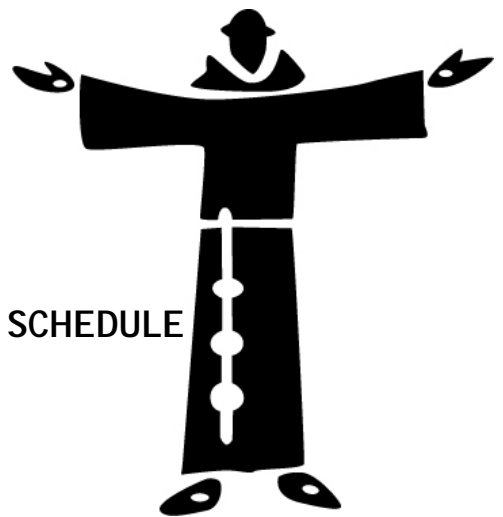
